# Getting ready to use Aerophone Brisa Plus

Connect the "Aerophone Brisa Plus" app that you installed on your mobile device with the Aerophone Brisa via Bluetooth®.

\* If you are connecting a device via Bluetooth that uses Android 6.0 or later, you need to activate location data on the Android device.

# Connecting to the Aerophone Brisa

### 1. Turn on the Aerophone Brisa.

The power indicator (orange) lights up.

#### MEMO

If you have more than one Aerophone Brisa, turn on only the unit that you want to connect (turn off all others).

#### 2. Set the Bluetooth setting of the Aerophone Brisa to "On".

The Bluetooth setting of the Aerophone Brisa is set to "Off" and the Bluetooth indicator (blue) is off when using the factory settings.

Follow the steps below to set the Bluetooth setting to "On".

- 1. Press the [MENU] button.
- Use the [◀] [▶] buttons to select "Bluetooth".



If "Off" is shown, press the [MENU] button and then press the [▶] button to select "On".

3. Place the Aerophone Brisa close to the mobile device that you want to connect.



#### 4. Turn on the Bluetooth function of the mobile device.



\* The display depends on the device you're using.

#### NOTE

Do not tap the "AE-BRISA" text shown in the Bluetooth settings screen of the mobile device. If you've tapped it, tap the "i" located beside "AE-BRISA connected" in the mobile device's screen, tap "Forget This Device" and start again from step 1.

Launch Aerophone Brisa Plus.

#### Select "Connect Aerophone Brisa".

The scan starts automatically.

#### NOTE

If you're using an Android device, the message "Allow Aerophone Brisa Plus to access this device's locations?" may be shown when you first launch the app. Select "Allow" so that you can use the Bluetooth functionality in this app.

#### Getting ready to use Aerophone Brisa Plus

\* If the scan is not successful, tap the "Scan" button on the screen.

 If more than one Aerophone Brisa is detected that can be connected, a selection screen appears.

### 7. If you see a pairing confirmation message, tap "Pair".



\* The display depends on the device you're using.

#### Once you see the message "Connected to AE-BRISA", tap the [OK] button.






### If the connection fails

If the connection fails, such as AE-BRISA not appearing after scanning, or not connecting when you tap the AE-BRISA you want to connect, try the following steps.

 From the Settings app on your mobile device, open the Bluetooth settings and tap "i" when AE-BRISA appears to delete the pairing information.

- Initialize Bluetooth on the Aerophone Brisa.
  - Press the [MENU] button.
  - 2. Use the [◀] [▶] buttons to select "Pro Menu", and then press the [MENU] button.
  - **3.** Use the [◀] [▶] buttons to select "Initialize", and then press the [MENU] button.
  - **4.** Use the [**4**] [**▶**] buttons to select "Bluetooth", and then press the [MENU] button.
  - Press the [▶] button to initialize.
  - Turn the power of the Aerophone Brisa off and then on again.
- Tap "Scan" on the Aerophone Brisa Plus screen.



4. Continue from step 7 of "Connecting to the Aerophone Brisa".



# Aerophone Brisa Plus: Overview

This app lets you check the status of the Aerophone Brisa itself as well as the status of connections to the Aerophone Brisa.

Shows the transpose value of the connected Aerophone Brisa.

Lets you check the status of connection to the Aerophone Brisa.



The Aerophone Brisa Plus has the following functions.

Use the buttons at the bottom of the screen to switch between the functions.

#### Favorite

Lets you confirm/switch between the currently selected tone and register/ switch between favorite tones.

### Fingering

When you press a performance key on the Aerophone Brisa, the corresponding part lights up onscreen, letting you check which pitch you played.

# Using the Favorite screen

The currently selected tone is shown.

Tap to show the tone list.

You can switch to any tone from the tone list.

→"Using the tone list screen'



Click on the numbers 1–5 to switch between favorite banks.

The tones that you've registered as favorites are shown here.

Press and hold a tone button to register the tone as a favorite.


You can also tap a tone button to switch to that tone.


# Registering tones as favorites

Follow the steps below to register a tone as a favorite.

1. Long-press where you want to register (save) the favorite.




When the tone list appears, select the tone you want to register and tap the [OK] button.





### 3. Tap the [OK] button.




4. The selected tone is registered as a favorite, and the display returns to the Favorite screen.


# Using the Setting screen

### Common

This tab lets you configure the parameters for the operations and performance of the Aerophone Brisa.

#### MIDI Assign

Sets the MIDI message assigned to the controller, such as the breath sensor.



### Setting the parameter values

Follow the steps below to set the parameter values.

### Tap the category of the parameter you want to change to expand it.



# Using the Information screen



| item                       | Explanation  |
|----------------------------|--|
| Version                    | Shows the version of the Aerophone Brisa and of the app.   |
| License                    | Shows the license text.  |
| Backup                     | Backs up the settings of this instrument (P.18). You can also restore previously backed-up settings (P.20).            |
| Connection                 | Shows a screen with the connection to the Aerophone Brisa.<br>You can connect and disconnect the Aerophone Brisa here. |
| App Manual                 | Shows the app's manual.  |
| Product Quick Start Manual | Shows the Quick Start manual for the Aerophone Brisa.  |
| Product Reference Manual   | Shows the Reference Manual for the Aerophone Brisa.  |
| Product Information        | Shows the Aerophone Brisa's product page on the Roland website.  |

# Making a backup

Here's how to save the settings on the Aerophone Brisa to another device or to cloud storage.

### 1. Tap "Backup".



### 2. Tap the item you want to back up.

### 3. Select the backup destination.

| Device | Saves to your device.                         |
|--------|---|
| Cloud  | Saves to cloud storage or a similar location. |



 Follow the onscreen prompts to choose a location for saving, and enter a filename.

This backs up the settings.



# Restoring a backup


Here's how to restore previously backed-up settings to the Aerophone Brisa.

#### 1. Tap "Backup".



### 2. Tap the item you want to restore.

3. Choose the location where the file you want to restore is saved.

| Device | Restores from a backup file saved on the device.                          |
|--------|---|
| Cloud  | Restores from a backup file saved in cloud storage or a similar location. |



4. Follow the onscreen instructions to select the backup file.

This restores the backup settings.
